The characteristics of a Value Chain is a market focused collaboration between business enterprises working together to produce value added products in the ever changing marketplace.

What benefits can Value Chains offer?

- Establish quality assurance & food safety protocol programs
- Drive cost reductions
- Reduce and/or share risk
- Create access to new markets or capital
- Build the critical mass needed to increase market share

- **Phase 1-Building Awareness**
Maximum \$30,000.00 per project
- **Phase 2-Value Chain Implementation**
Maximum \$70,000.00 per project

 - Value chain development
 - Market assessment
 - Product development
 - Preliminary feasibility analysis
 - Market verification of opportunity
 - Education & awareness projects

- **Phase 2 Eligible Activities**

- Enhanced value chain development
- Detailed feasibility analysis
- Marketing activities
- Initiating & managing a value chain pilot project
- Identify quality assurance and/or food safety system development requirements
- Limited funding for trade show activities
